Thursday, June 25 “Snowed In’ Bunny and cardinals in a snowscene painted on a large snowflake cut out. Snowflake approximately 16”, scene area approximately 8”. This is a great beginner project but will be enjoyed by all levels.

Friday, June 26, Saturday, June 27, Sunday, June 28 “Just Desserts” fruits, birds and florals on a cake plate (approximately 15” with a 2.5” skirt) designed especially design for this project. Skirt has a traditional Zhostovo border design. This project was taught in Japan, in four separate seminars, with 30 students per seminar.
